Y. and that the said Company own one half (1/2) and that H. H. Fargo resides at the same place, and own one half (1/2) and that they are the citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Propeller Vessel called Galena of Buffalo whereof B. A. Root is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1879 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 17, 1867, renumbered 111. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two Decks and one Mast and that her length is 190 feet, her breadth is 30 feet, her depth 19 feet, and that she measures 812 Tons and 96 hundredths, viz:
