# ENROLLMENT.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that James S. McLowan resides at the same place, and that they are

citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Brig or Vessel called Rio Grande of Buffalo whereof Edward Collins is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or Vessel was built at Sodusburg, N. Y. in the year 1826 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 8, 1840, numbered 106. Now surrendered having changed Owner.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is 116 feet, her breadth is 24 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures Two hundred Three 203. Tons and 05 hundredths, viz:
