Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Stephen D. Baldwin
having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that E. A. Buck resides at the same place, and that Jay Gould and A. H. Blanchard reside at New York, N. Y. and that they are

citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Propeller Vessel called St. Louis of Buffalo whereof S. D. Baldwin is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1864 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 10, 1869, and Numbered 198.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two Deck and one Mast and that her length is 192 feet, her breadth is 31 feet, her depth 11 feet, and that she measures
