Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

*Franklin Lee*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and owns *One half (1/2)* and that *Samuel L. Watson and Henry L. Moore* reside at *the same place*, and *each own One fourth (1/4)* and that they are

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Barge* or Vessel called *Racine* of *Buffalo* whereof *Henry L. Moore* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn *that he* is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Barge* or Vessel was built at *Tonawanda, N. Y.* in the year *1864*

as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 29, 1870, numbered 121.* *Now surrendered having changed Owners.*

And *said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Barge* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *Three* Mast and that her length is *194* feet, her breadth is *30* feet, her depth *11* feet, her height *10* feet,

and that she measures *524* Tons and *24* hundredths, viz:
