Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and that H. C. Kinslow resides at New York, N.Y. and that they are

citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Barge Vessel called Favorite of Buffalo, whereof Henry C. Kinslow at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or Vessel was built at Newport, Mich in the year 1862 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 20, 1866, numbered 26. Now surrendered having changed Owners.
