*and* ~~citizen of the United States~~ sole owners of the Propeller Vessel called *Idaho*, of *Buffalo* whereof *Burton Penney* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller Vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio* in the year *1863* as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated April 29, 1864, & numbered 72.*
