Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Grand Island, N. Y.* and that she is a

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Sug Prop* vessel called *Robert J. L. Cooper* of *Grand Island*, whereof *James A. Morgan* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Sug Prop* vessel was built at *Grand Island, N. Y.* in the year 1870 as appears by the *Certificate of R. J. L. Cooper, shipwright, her builder. On file in this Office.*

And *Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor* having certified that the said *Sug Prop* vessel has *One* Deck and *No* Mast and that her length is *37* feet, her breadth is *9* feet, her depth *4* feet, her height *10* feet,

and that she measures *Six (6) Tons and 52* hundredths, viz:
