Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

John Kelderhouse, having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is a

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Propeller Vessel called Mendota of Buffalo, whereof J. B. Hathaway is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1857 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 26, 1870, numbered 117. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two Decks and One Mast and that her length is 192 feet, her breadth is 30 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures
