Y.* in the year *1864* as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated May 12, 1864, and numbered 99, now surrendered vessel having been repaired, and tonnage increased* And *Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor* having certified that the said *Ing Prop* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *no* Mast and that her length is *49* feet, her breadth is *14* feet, her depth *7* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *26* Tons and *46* hundredths, viz:
