# ENROLLMENT.

District of Buffalo Creek, Port of Buffalo.

Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Henry C. Winslow

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is Attorney of H. C. Winslow of New York who owns Eight Sixteenths (8/16) and that H. J. Winslow of the same place, owns Six Sixteenths (6/16) and that R. S. Kolvin of Chicago, Ill. owns Two Sixteenths (2/16), and that they are

citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Propeller Vessel called Dean Richmond of Buffalo whereof R. S. Kolvin is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio, in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago, Ill. dated April 15, 1870, numbered 181. Now surrendered, Vessel having arrived at her Home Port.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two Decks and one Mast and that her length is 226 feet, her breadth is 34 feet, her depth 21 feet, her height 10 feet,

and that she measures 1416 Tons and 42 hundredths, viz:

that she is a Propeller has a plain head and a round stern.

And the said Henry C. Winslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Acts, the said Propeller Dean Richmond has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
