Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is Attorney of H. C. Kinslow of New York, who owns three fourths (3/4), and Sethat, B. S. Wolvin of Chicago, Ill. own one fourth (1/4), and that they are citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Barque or Vessel called L. C. Woodruff of Buffalo whereof John Coulter is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barque or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1866 as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Register at the Port of Milwaukee, Wis. dated April 22, 1870 & numbered 1. Now surrendered, vessel having arrived her home Port. And said Register having certified that the said Barque or Vessel has One Deck and three Masts and that her length is 170 feet, her breadth is 23 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 548 Tons and 90 hundredths, viz:
