Blyden is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at East Saginaw Mich, in the year 1868 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at the Port of Port Huron, Mich, dated Aug 7, 1868, numbered 86.
