Y.* in the year *1869*, as appears by *the Certificate of James Barnard, Shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.*

And *Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor* having certified that the said *Canal Boat* Vessel has *One* Deck and *No* Mast and that her length is *95* feet, her breadth is *17* feet, her depth is *8* feet, and that she measures *110* Tons and *88* hundredths, viz:
