ENROLLMENT.

District of Buffalo Creek, Port of Buffalo.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Charles E. Madden

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y., and that he is Executor of the Estate of the late Edward Madden, and that he is a

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called Kattie Sherman of Buffalo, whereof Frank Noble is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1844 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 10, 1866, and Numbered 169, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is 102 feet, her breadth is 22 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height and that she measures 167 Tons and 27 hundredths, viz:

that she is a Schooner has a plain head and a square head stern.
