ENROLLMENT.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and that *P. B. Hitchcock* resides at *the same place* and under the firm name of *Hitchcock & Gibson*, own *One half (1/2)*, and that *James D. Mauir* and *John Gibson* reside at *the same place*, and each own *One fourth (1/4)*, and that they are citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called *Gibson* of *Buffalo*, whereof *James D. Mauir* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at *Buffalo, N. Y.* in the year *1870* as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 28, 1870, numbered 151. Now surrendered having changed Owners.*

And *said Enrollment* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One* Deck and *two* Mast and that her length is *120* feet, her breadth is *26* feet, her depth is *10* feet, her height is *10* feet, and that she measures *257* Tons and *55* hundredths, viz:
