Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Charlton Thompson

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N.Y. and owns two thirds (2/3), and that William Thompson resides at the same place, and owns one third (1/3), and that they are*

citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Sug Prop* Vessel called *Skinnie Brown* of *Buffalo*, whereof *Charlton Thompson* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn *that he* is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Sug Prop* Vessel was built at *Buffalo, N.Y.* in the year *1869* as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Sept 16 1869, surrendered by, now surrendered, having changed Owners.*

And *said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Sug Prop* Vessel has *One* Deck and *No* Mast and that her length is *25* feet, her breadth is *10* feet, her depth *4* feet, and that she measures
