said Banal Boat Vessel was built at Lockport, N. Y. in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 6, 1869, numbered 121, now surrendered having changed owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Banal Boat vessel has One Deck and No Mast and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth is 17 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet,
