Avery resides at the same place, and owns One Sixth (1/6), and that they are citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Barge or Vessel called *Erastus Corning* of Buffalo, whereof *George H. Clarke* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or Vessel was built at *Lawanda, N. Y.* in the year 1864, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Sept. 7, 1868, numbered 42, now surrendered having changed Managing Owner. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barge or Vessel has One Deck and Three Masts and that her length is 204 feet, her breadth is 25 feet, her depth 14 feet, and that she measures 822 Tons and 43 hundredths, viz:
