And *Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor* having certified that the said *Canal Boat* vessel has *One* Deck and *two* Mast and that her length is *94* feet, her breadth is *14* feet, her depth *7* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *106* Tons and *10* hundredths, viz:
