Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States.

*Sarah E. King* having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that she resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and that she is a

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called *George D. Russell* of *Buffalo* whereof *J. J. Randon* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at *Lalade, Ohio* in the year 1870

as appears by the certificate of her Temporary Register at the Port of *Lalade, Ohio* dated July 14, 1870, and numbered 1. Now surrendered vessel having arrived at *Buffalo, N. Y.* And said Register having certified her

that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One* Deck and *three* Masts and that her length is *198* feet, her breadth is *34* feet, her depth is *12* feet, her height is *10* feet,

and that she measures *658* Tons and *22* hundredths, viz:
