Spillings* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Steam Yacht* or vessel was built at *Grand Island, N.Y.* in the year 1872 as appears by the certificate of *Charles H. Jones*, *On file in this office.* And *Alonso H. Scriven, Surveyor*

having certified that the said *Steam Yacht* vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *44* feet, her breadth *8* feet, her depth *4* feet, her height *10* feet; that she measures *fourteen (14)* tons and *49* hundredths, viz.:
