IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Alexander Petrie of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ if a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Anson Roberts, of Buffalo, whereof Alex. Petrie is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States,

and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1868, as appears by her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 24, 1871. Her number is 155. The Certificate of which has been lost as appears by the affidavits of Alexander Petrie, on file in this Office. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat

has One deck and one mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet; that she measures 122 tons and 26 hundredths, viz.:
