Urial Driggs of Tonawanda, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Banal Boat or vessel called the J. J. Bennett, of Buffalo, whereof Urial Driggs is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Banal Boat or vessel was built at Tonawanda, N.
