IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Joseph E. Badcock of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with George D. Barr of the same place, are

(each one half) citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Banal Boat vessel called the John H. Drake, of Buffalo, whereof Joseph E. Badcock is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Banal Boat or vessel was built at Fulton, N. Y. in the year 1868, as appears by her last Enrollment at the Port of Oswego, N. Y. dated May 15, 1869, numbered 36, now surrendered having changed Owner to District.
