IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

A. L. Lothridge of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Nathaniel Nelson and Wm. J. Russell of the same place, are

(each one third) citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the E. P. & H. Loomis, of Buffalo, whereof A. L. Lothridge is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Amawanda, N. Y. in the year 1842 as appears by the Certificate of J. P. Haskin, Shipwright her builder, on file in this Office. And George H. Scriven, Surveyor

having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and Sq. mast, and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet; that she measures 118 tons and 89 hundredths, viz.:
