IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John A. Bager of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath. required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with it a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the ~~Banal Boat~~ vessel called the Hankie Cannon, of Buffalo, whereof John A. Bager is at present Master, and as he hath

sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Banal Boat or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y.

in the year 1841 as appears by her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 4 1840, & numbered 106. The Certificate of which had been lost and appeared by the Affidavit of J. A. Bager on file in this Office.

Said Enrollment having certified that the said Banal Boat or vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet; that she measures 110 tons and 88 hundredths, viz.:
