IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Charles Williams of Buffalo, N. Y. being taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with \_\_\_\_\_ is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Leona Lehn or vessel called the J. B. Paine, of Buffalo whereof Charles Williams is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Leona Lehn or vessel was built at Fairport, Ohio in the year 1866 as appears by her last Enrollment at the Port of Suspension Bridge, N. Y. dated June 19, 1872, numbered 21. Leona Lehn transferred having changed Owner & District.
