IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Charles Starbird of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~is~~ is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat vessel called the D. Leonard, of Buffalo whereof Charles Starbird is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Rochester, N. Y. in the year 1862 as appears by her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 2, 1866, numbered 224. Now surrendered having changed District to Buffalo, N. Y. And said Enrollment
