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IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Joseph D. Blake of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Sloop Propeller vessel called the Bell Shore, of Buffalo, whereof Joseph D. Blake is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1843, as appears by the Certificate of John H. Kingston, Shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office. And George H. Gerwin, Surveyor

having certified that the said Sloop Propeller vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 29 feet, her breadth 11 feet, her depth 5 feet, her height 10 feet; that she measures Ten (10) tons and 58 hundredths, viz.:

that she is a Sloop Propeller has a beam head and a round stern.

And the said Joseph D. Blake having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
