IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

A. L. Lothridge of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Abraham Nelson and Wm J. Russell of the same place, and each own two twelfths (2/12), and that J. M. Covell of the same place, own six twelfths (6/12), and that they are

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Banal Boat or vessel called the John B. Baker, of Buffalo whereof A. L. Lothridge is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Banal Boat or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.
