IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

James M. Taylor of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with John Murphy of Cheykill Haven, Penn., are

each one half citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Canal Boat vessel called the Ethan Murphy, of Buffalo, whereof James M. Taylor is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Schapa, N. Y. in the year 1842 as appears by the Certificate of A. Van Orden, shipwright her builder. On file in this Office. And George H. Teriver, Surveyor, having certified that the said Canal Boat vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 1/2 feet, her depth 16 feet, her height 10 feet; that she measures 121 tons and 20 hundredths, viz.:
