IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Mr. F. O'Rourke of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Joseph E. Hadcock of the same place, are

citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Canal Boat vessel called the B. L. Abel, of Buffalo whereof Mr. F. O'Rourke is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Lockport, N.Y. in the year 1872 as appears by the certificate of J. H. Lewis, shipwright her builder. On file in this office.

And Emanuel Kahn, Surveyor, Troy, N.Y. having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 14 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet; that she measures 124 tons and 21 hundredths, viz.:
