IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Edgar Baught of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~is~~ is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the ~~Canal Boat~~ vessel called the Edgar Baught, of Buffalo whereof Edgar Baught is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said ~~Canal Boat~~ vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1842 as appears by the Certificate of Edgar Baught, shipwright her builder, on file in this Office.

And Alonso Sherman Surveyor having certified that the said ~~Canal Boat~~ vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 14 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet; that she measures 126 tons and 74 hundredths, viz.:
