John M. Annis of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, with it a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the ~~Small Boat~~ or vessel called the Central Bank, of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said ~~Small Boat~~ or vessel was built at North Bay, N.Y. in the year 1842 as appears by the certificate of John M.
