L. Danforth of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~owns~~ *owns (12/16) Thirteen Sixteenths, and that James Beyer of the same place owns (2/16) Three Sixteenths, and that they are*
