IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

*Henry C. Hinckley* of *Ruffalo, N. Y.* taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having *sworn* that he, *together with* *his attorney* of *H. J. Hinckley* of *New York*, who owns *Eight Fifteenth (8/16)* and that *R. K. Hinckley* of *Cleveland, Ohio*, owns *Six Sixteenth (6/16)* and that *A. E. Adeworth* of *Cleveland, Ohio*, owns *Two Sixteenth (2/16)*, and that they are citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner of vessel called the *Brightie*, of *Ruffalo*, whereof *E. A. Keller* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio*, in the year 1868, as appears by *her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 10, 1872 & numbered 11, now surrendered having changed owners* And said Enrollment.
