ENROLMENT in conformity to 'Title L, "Regulation of Vessels in Domestic Commerce," of the Revised Statutes of the United States,

Hugh Skallon of Buffalo, N. Y.

having taken and subscribed the Oath required by law, and having sworn that he ,

owns three eighths (3/8), and that Thomas G. Skallon, Hugh S. Skallon and Letitia J. Galvin (formerly Letitia J. Martin) of the same place, each own one eighth (1/8)

and that Thomas J. Lovell of the same place, own two eighths (2/8), and that they are citizens of the United States, sole owners of the ship or vessel called the John D. Griffin, of Buffalo, whereof Hugh Skallon is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said ship or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1844, as appears by her last Enrolment at this Port, dated July 12, 1877, numbered 4. Now surrendered having changed owners.
