having taken and subscribed the Oath required by law, and having sworn that he, together with his trustee for Henry H. Coult of the same place, who sit as

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the ship or vessel called the *Leo Lennox*, of *Buffalo*, whereof *Theodore E. Coult* is at present Master, and is a citizen of the United States, and that the said ship or vessel was built at *Buffalo, N.
