In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Michael Mitchell having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with John Q. Swan reside at Buffalo, N. Y. and that they are

(each one half 1/2) sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Citizen of Buffalo whereof Michael Mitchell is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Erie, Pa. in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Register at the Port of Erie, Pa. dated Aug 12, 1870 & numbered 2. How surrendered Vessel having arrived at her Home Port. said Register having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 87. 2/10 feet, her breadth 22. 2/10 feet, her depth 8. 2/10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 116. tons and 27 hundredths, viz:
