In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Pascal P. Pratt having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with resided at Buffalo, N.Y. and that he is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Helen Pratt of Buffalo whereof Joseph Collins is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, New York in the year 1840, as appears by the Certificate of Geo. H. Katter, Shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.

And Alonzo H. Scriven having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 115 feet, her breadth 26 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 212 tons and 28 hundredths, viz:
