

ENROLMENT No. 47 Permanent.

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Thomas P. Justin having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with resided at Buffalo, N.Y. and that he is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Sloop Propeller vessel called the Franklin of Buffalo whereof Thomas P. Justin is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Propeller vessel was built at Fultonville, N.Y. in the year 1865, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated June 25, 1870, numbered 208, now surrendered having changed owners.

And said Enrolment, having certified that the said Sloop Propeller vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 41 feet, her breadth 11 feet, her depth 5 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 14 tons and 98 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Sloop Propeller has a spar head, and a round stern. And the said Thomas P. Justin having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
