In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John P. Irish of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with William R. Marshall of Oneida, N. Y. are

(each one half) sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Buffalo, whereof John P. Irish is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Rochester, N. Y. in the year 1867, as appears by her last Enrolment at this Port, dated August 24, 1869 & numbered 47. The Certificate of which had been lost as appears by the Oath of John P. Irish. On file in And said Enrolment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No. mast, and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 147 tons and 65 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat, has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said John P. Irish, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
