In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

*John Bluned* having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ resided at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and owns *Two thirds (2/3)*, and that *George H. King* resided at *Huron Station Mich.* and owns *One third (1/3)*, and that they are

sole owners of the *Sloop Schooner* or vessel called the *Keollie* citizens of the United States, and of *Buffalo* whereof *John Bluned* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Sloop Schooner* vessel was built at *Huron River, Mich.* in the year *1867*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at the Port of *Toledo, Ohio*, dated *June 11, 1870* & numbered *69* now surrendered having changed Owners & District, and said Enrolment having certified that the said *Sloop Schooner* vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *76* feet,  $\frac{4}{10}$  her breadth *19* feet,  $\frac{4}{10}$  her depth *4* feet,  $\frac{6}{10}$  her height *10* feet, and that she measures *59* tons and *38* hundredths, viz:

That she is a *Sloop Schooner* has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said *John Bluned* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said *Sloop Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo, N. Y.*
