(each one half (1/2)) citizens of the United States, and
 sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Barlingford of
 Buffalo whereof J. A. Carson is at present Master.
 and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States,
 and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Port Huron, Mich
 in the year 1869, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrolment at
 that Port, dated Sept 27, 1869, numbered 71, now surrendered having
 changed Owners. And said Enrolment

having certified that the
 said Schooner or vessel has one deck and Three masts, and that
 her length is 154 feet, 7 feet,
 her breadth 21 feet, 10 feet,
 her depth 12 feet, 10 feet,
 her height 10 feet, 10 feet,
