And said Enrolment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 97. ⁸/₁₀ feet, her breadth 17. ⁶/₁₀ feet, her depth 9. ²/₁₀ feet, her height 10 ¹⁰/₁₀ feet, and that she measures 126. tons and 04. hundredths, viz:
