In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Stephen H. Borth of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with R. H. Dunke of Laginaw, Mich, and what they are

(each one half) sole owners of the Canal Boat vessel called the Star No. 2 of Buffalo whereof Stephen H. Borth is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at Laginaw, Mich in the year 1866, as appears by her last Enrolment at this Port, dated Sept 18, 1866 & numbered 225. The certificate of which has been lost & appeared by the affidavit of Stephen H. Borth, On file in said said Enrolment having certified that the said Canal Boat vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 92 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 114 tons and H2 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Stephen H. Borth, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
