sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Allen Monroe of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Rochester, N.Y. in the year 1865, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment issued at this Port, dated May 26, 1870. & numbered 190. Now surrendered having changed owners. And said Enrolment. having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No. mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 123 tons and 83 hundredths, viz:

And the said Perry Burr having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
