 "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and 1864.

In Conformity to an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and the Acts of the 7th

John Warner required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with his wife, resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the "Buffalo" whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Rochester, N.Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Rochester, N.Y. dated May 23, 1866, and numbered 299, now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 96 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 126 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said John P. Irish having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
