citizen of the United States, and is at present Master of the vessel called the Salt Springs of Syracuse, N.Y. is a citizen of the United States, the certificate of her last Enrolment dated May 22, 1869, & numbered 276, now surrendered having changed Owners & District.

And said Enrolment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 103 and 14 hundredths, viz:
