

ENROLMENT No. 80.

Permanent.

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

James Boyd having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ resides at *Penbrooke, N.Y.* and that he is a

sole owner of the *Canal Boat* or vessel called the *Buffalo* whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Canal Boat* or vessel was built at *Syracuse, N.Y.* in the year *1857*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at the Port of *New York*, dated *May 22, 1869*, & numbered *276*, now surrendered having changed District.

And said Enrolment having certified that the said *Canal Boat* or vessel has *One* deck and *No* mast, and that her length is *95* feet, her breadth *17* feet, her depth *7* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *103* tons and *14* hundredths, viz:

That she is a *Canal Boat*, has a *flair* head, and a *square* stern. And the said *James Boyd*, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said *Canal Boat* has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo, N.Y.*
